If any runs are scratched due to weather (rain / heat / cold or snow), entry fees for those runs can be rolled over to a future trial at the owner's request.

Confirmations:

Verification of the entry received will be sent upon receipt of your entry form and payment, an actual confirmation with Trial Instructions will be emailed no later than the Tuesday morning prior to the trial.

Our rings are fully fenced but not gated. Temporary training gates can be placed across the Entry and Exit chutes at the handler's request.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **CJR Ventures, LLC d/b/a K9 Corps Agility** (including its officers, directors, members, and **Bittersweet Farm, LLC** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and event organizing committee), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Lodging Info and Directions:

Bittersweet Farm is located about 10 minutes west of Interstate 41 at the south end of Oshkosh. It is not easy to find – allow extra time the first time you are coming to this facility!

As is often the case with agility trial sites, Google Maps will not actually get you there; it will drop you off in a cul-de-sac just to the west of the property and you will NOT be able to see anything that resembles an equestrian facility so PLEASE follow these directions and avoid confusion / frustration:

The simplest way to get there is to take Interstate 41 toward Oshkosh, exit at Highway 26 and proceed WEST on 26.

Almost right away you will see signs for County Trunk N, turn right on N and take that southwest to County FF.

Turn left on County FF then keep your eyes peeled for the entrance to Bittersweet Farm ON YOUR LEFT. You can NOT see the arena from County FF, it's a private driveway, rather inconspicuous, which goes through about ¼ mile of wooded area before you get to the riding arena.

We will bring along our Festivus Pole to put out by the road so you can find the driveway.

ENTRY PROCEDURE FOR THIS TRIAL:

This facility has a limited crating area – we do not want anyone coming to be forced to work out of their car or to feel uncomfortable because we have to cram too many dogs into a small space. Therefore, we are limiting runs to 250 per day so that everyone is comfortable and we can maintain a relaxed trial environment.

If this trial does not fill, we will accept all entries. If we receive entries for more than 250 runs on either or both days, we will hold a draw immediately upon closing of the entry period. K9 Corps Agility members will receive priority entry, the remaining runs will be filled for each day by draw until we reach the maximum number of runs for that day.

If you enter this trial, you will be notified by email on Thursday evening, March 14, as to whether your entry has been accepted. Any entry fees submitted for runs not drawn will be immediately returned after the draw.
