Paul Kirk Silver Buckle Series 2019 will consist of a combination of Q's for all ASCA trials held at Sunrise Ranch in the 2019 season. We will award Buckles at the trial December 7/8, 2019. Complete rules and entry forms will be available at the January trial and will be posted on the website www.macagility.club.

There will be four belt Buckles awarded Elite, Open, Novice and Veteran.

Event Rules: This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. Exhibitors, through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of ASCA, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. No entry will be accepted by any dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs or anyone not in good standing with ASCA. Equipment list: Slat-less Aluminum rubber covered contact obstacles (A-Frame 5'3", Teeter, Dog walk), open tunnels, winged & non winged jumps, weave poles (24 inch spacing).

Club Rules: All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Move-ups will be allowed at the trial from Saturday to Sunday. See the score table before the end of Saturday's trial for move up forms.

ALL DOGS CAN COMPETE AND EARN TITLES AT ASCA AGILITY TRIALS

ASCA requires a 'tracking' number for all non-ASCA registered dogs if you wish to have your scores recorded for titles. If you are not concerned about ASCA titles, you do not need register your dog to enter and compete in the trial. ALL dogs entering at 20 inches or less must be measured, or present a permanent jump height card from ASCA, AKC or NADAC. You may have the judge measure your dog, and apply for an ASCA Jump height card. Forms available from ASCA or www.macagility.club, or at the score table

ACE

ACE Senior Dog Division/Program

ACE Standard Division: Dog Jumps 4 inches lower than CH Division and receives 10% more time than the CH Division.

ACE Senior Dog Division (dogs ten or older) gives the dog an additional 10% and another four inches off the ACE division jump height.

20 inch dog in the ACE Senior Dog division jumps 12 inches.

- 1.1 As used here "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs, and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/ owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules, and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirements of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event, and the event premises, including but not limited to, the conditions of the grounds, lighting, security measures, or lack thereof, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, the presence of unfamiliar animals, and people, and assumes the risk of harm arising from any of these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases ASCA including all officers, directors, employees, and members, ASCSC, Inc, Manzanita Agility Club, Melinda Starkweather including all employees, officers, directors, agents members, organizing committees, and will defend and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event, or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes responsibility for and agrees to indemnify, and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses including legal fees by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my/our participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties, or any of their employees, agents or any other persons. *The scoring program will automatically assign your dog the lower jump height and give him more time. Please check his normal Ch division jump height. Senior Dog in the ACE Division will allow your dog to jump four inches lower and give him 10% more time than in the Standard Division of ACE. Senior dogs must be ten or over.
