Entry regulations:

- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must (1) have postage or be metered and (2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS and DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender.
- A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- If necessary, a draw for an alternates list will be held from the remaining entries after limits have been reached.
- After the closing date and time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Time 2 Beat: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Agility Regulations. Please note the weave poles will have 24-inch spacing.

Site information

Show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. The building will be vacated nightly at the close of the trial. No dogs may be left overnight. Ring size is at least 93 x 93 feet. All classes will be held on turf indoors, climate-controlled. Snacks and water cooler will be available (bring your own water bottle). Further information will be on k9x.org and/or from Lotus Kiffe..

Entry fees (per trial/day):

- \$25 for first entry of each dog each day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)
- \$20 for 2nd entry of each dog each day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee)
- \$18 for 3rd entry of each dog each day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee)
- \$15 for each add'l entry of each dog each day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee)

Paper entries:

Make all checks payable in U.S. funds to: **Trials By Lotus (not K9X!)**. All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front and back are accepted only if legible and official AKC size.

Entries will not be accepted without fees and signature on agreement on back of entry form. Please waive "signature required" on all expedited entries. Send entries to Trials By Lotus, 923 Palos Verdes, Leander, TX 78641. Specify K-9 Xpress on the envelope.

Online entries:

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com only(not through AKC). During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. Go www.labtestedonline.com to create a user account and add your dogs. Then search by state for Texas. Click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's May trial to create your entry.

Move-ups:

Move-ups for the first day of the trial will be accepted in writing prior to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 12, 2020. Send email move-ups to trialsbylotus@gmail.com. Move-ups for the subsequent days of this trial will be accepted no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the trial on Saturday on forms provided. Per Chapter 1, Section 20, exhibitors may show up at the trial site and request a move up in writing to the trial secretary not later than the day preceding the event. Also, a dog that has been entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be moved to the Novice B class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice A class to a Novice B class.

Vendors:

Crating space is limited; therefore, there will be no vendors.

Course familiarization and warm-ups:

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided.

RV hookups:

There are no RV hookups onsite. Dry camping is allowed for a fee. Contact DePaw for info. Parking is limited. There is a KOA 3.5 miles away. 2689 Hero Way, Leander, TX 78641, 512-259-7200.

There is a KOA within 4 miles of the trial site that accepts RV's.

VMO:

There will NOT be a Volunteer Measuring Official at these trials.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in Standard, Jumpers With Weaves and FAST. Only 1st place ribbons are awarded in the T2B titling class.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New Title and MACH/PACH/PAX ribbons and MACH/PACH/PAX bars will also be awarded.

Dogs eligible to enter:

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Attention, volunteers!!!

Austin K-9 Xpress appreciates everyone who helps make our trials successful by contributing their time. With your e-mailed final confirmation will be a link to sign up online for ring crews. We will also have volunteer sign-up sheets at the trial.

Workers will receive a voucher toward any future K-9 Xpress trials. The Chief Ring Steward will distribute the vouchers to workers in the ring. We will also have snacks available for our volunteers.

Notice to exhibitors

- Choke collars, pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- Austin K-9 Xpress and DePaw Dog Sports assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property—and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Austin K-9 Xpress and DePaw Dog Sports and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to crates when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up areas.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- **If the entry form is photocopied or faxed, the agreement on the back of the form must also be photocopied or faxed and attached to the entry when it is mailed or faxed. Entry forms cannot be accepted if they are unsigned or if they specify any conditions as to its acceptance.**
- No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete or **be on the trial grounds**. For bitches in season, entry fees minus \$10.00 per day will be refunded if a vet's certificate and written notification is provided. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification by 6:00 pm the day before the first day of the trial.
- Austin K-9 Xpress reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Austin K-9 Xpress or any official thereof.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
